

ACSII's second major summit, ACSIS 2025 in London underscored a powerful mandate for intentional Africa-Caribbean collaboration, spotlighting innovation, investment, data sovereignty, and people-centred development as foundations for shared progress.

AFRICAN CARIBBEAN SUSTAINABILITY & INVESTMENT SUMMIT

SUMMARY

The African Caribbean Sustainability & Investment Summit (ACSIS) 2025 convened leaders, investors, policymakers, innovators and diaspora representatives in London to deepen collaboration between Africa and the Caribbean and accelerate sustainable, inclusive growth. The Summit theme; **Empowering Futures: Uniting Africa and the Caribbean through Sustainable Innovation and Inclusive Growth**, framed two days of strategic dialogue spanning economic resilience, social empowerment, technology, cultural identity and reparative justice.

2025 EVENT HIGHLIGHTS

Day One opened with Chair David Roberts emphasising that the Summit is a strategic platform for connecting communities through innovation, investment and partnership. Speakers explored resilience in the face of global challenges, identifying adaptive governance, gender-inclusive entrepreneurship, climate-adaptive development, and equitable health systems as essential to sustainable growth. The Blue Economy's £8 trillion potential was highlighted alongside calls for governance reform and local value-added development. Panels stressed sustainable healthcare, women's leadership, ecocide law to protect biodiversity, financial innovation, heritage tourism, tech-driven cross-regional partnerships, smart cities, and ownership of logistics infrastructure. A vision for an Africa-Caribbean tech corridor underscored the Summit's

ambition to mobilise actionable capital flows and collaborative innovation

Day Two deepened diplomatic and practical commitments to unity, resource ownership and community investment. High commissioners and speakers stressed accountability and strategic partnerships. Delegates championed women-led enterprise, youth empowerment, financial inclusion, and data sovereignty. Discussions on cultural entrepreneurship and diaspora narratives emphasised cultural power as economic currency. Sessions on health inequities and food sovereignty highlighted historic trauma's impact and solutions rooted in traditional systems. A strong reparative justice arc culminated in calls for holistic, tangible frameworks to address historic inequality, asserting that reparations are justice, not charity. Closing remarks called for investment in African and Caribbean business and strong, self-led ecosystems.

WORLD REPARATIONS CONFERENCE

PURPOSE

The World Reparations Conference (WRC) is to convene global stakeholders – Governments, Civil Society, Academia, Private Sector, and the African and Caribbean diasporas – for a focused, strategic dialogue on advancing reparations and restitution efforts rooted in historical truth, collective dignity, and intergenerational justice.

2025 EVENT HIGHLIGHTS

The first WRC was hosted last year at the House of Lords, Parliament Square, London (25th September 2025). The WRC launched its “Pathways to Reparative Justice” session under the theme “Truth, Dignity, and Repair – For Generations to Come,” convening activists, policymakers, economists, and business leaders to shape practical frameworks addressing the enduring legacies of slavery and colonialism.

Speakers including Bell Ribeiro-Addy MP (Chair, APPG on Afrikan Reparations), Esther Xosei (reparationist, jurisconsult), and Dr R. David Muir (Cambridge)–stressed that reparations must extend beyond finance to education reform, systemic change, and restored dignity. Ibukun Adebayo (CEO, Restitution Capital) linked high borrowing costs and “corruption premiums” in emerging markets to colonial legacies, urging reparative economic frameworks centred on transparency and sustainable growth.

Personal reflections from Heirs of Slavery, led by co-founder John Dower, brought descendants of enslavers into dialogue with descendants of enslaved peoples, underlining the moral complexity of repair.

Deliberations examined: the economics of reparations and corporate accountability; the case for a national programme—including Haiti’s historic extraction, outlined by Dr Kridikel Truthbey (Sixth Region, USA); community-led approaches to inclusion; and the role of institutions—from Parliament and the Church to media such as The Guardian—in acknowledging and addressing ties to slavery.

The session closed with a collective call to policymakers, business, and diaspora communities to collaborate on education, equity, and empowerment—ensuring reparative justice translates into tangible economic and social outcomes.
